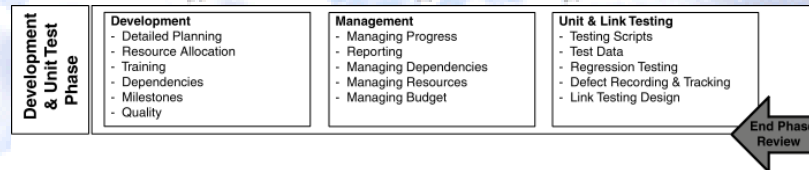

7.3 Introduction

This section covers the development phase of the programme or project. The development is driven from the design and requirements phases, if there is any aspect of the design and/or requirements phase that remains unclear it must be addressed before the development phase starts.

Any error in the design and/or requirement gathering will only be compounded in the development phase, so do not progress your project to the development phase until the design and/or requirements phase is complete and signed off.

The development phase is the time when the design, previously signed off, gets interpreted into a logical and physical design. This phase is key to forging the final delivery and must be managed closely to ensure the design and requirements are being met.
